### Introduction

WHO predicts that one in four persons in the developed world will develop cancer even though medical science has made significant progress. About 70% of all patients diagnosed with cancer i'll eventually die of the disease. This is very troubling fact but nonetheless we have to come to terms with it and be prepared. Health care professionals are so focussed on cure that they sometimes forget that they cannot always cure. Thus, at the same point in time we have to change our focus to care.

Health care professionals will be seeing an increasing number of patients with advanced life limiting illness and must be prepared to offer all reasonable options available to them.

Traditional health care professionals have very little formal training in dealing with patients with life limiting illnesses such as terminal cancer. The importance of communicating difficult information and end of life care has gained more attention in medical practice in recent times. Relieving patients suffering and optimising their quality of life should be high priorities for all health care professionals.

Currently palliative medicine is now being practised in mainstream medicine as its services are now being made available to all tertiary MOH hospitals. MOH has launched the National Palliative care policy and strategic plan 2019-2030. It's a comprehensive and holistic framework moving palliative care a leap forward by providing accessible care to those in need.

The objective of this seminar is to provide health care professionals with formal learning and training sessions in palliative care. This seminar workshops will be conducted by specialists in palliative medicine.
